

# KASH IN AT CONGRESS

## OFFICIAL INCENTIVE RULES - 2027 BREEDING YEAR

### \$15,000 TOTAL INCENTIVE

This incentive is exclusively for **Kash Money** offspring resulting from the 2027 breeding year and competing in the **2 Year Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Stakes** at the **2030 All American Quarter Horse Congress**.

**\$10,000** distributed among the Top 10 placing eligible **Kash Money** offspring in the **2 Year Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Stakes**.

**PLUS \$5,000** bonus if an eligible **Kash Money** offspring wins the class.

#### 1. Eligibility

Horse must be an offspring of **Kash Money** resulting from the 2027 breeding year and must be properly registered with a Congress-accepted breed registry. Sire identity must be verifiable through official registration and/or parentage records. The horse must be properly entered and compete in the designated class at the **2030 All American Quarter Horse Congress**.

#### 2. Designated Class

This private incentive applies only to the **2 Year Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Stakes** at the **2030 All American Quarter Horse Congress**.

#### 3. \$10,000 Top-10 Incentive

The \$10,000 incentive purse will be paid to eligible **Kash Money** offspring resulting from the 2027 breeding year that place within the official Top 10 of the **2 Year Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Stakes** at the 2030 Congress. The \$10,000 will be divided equally among all eligible **Kash Money** offspring appearing in the official Top 10. If only one eligible **Kash Money** offspring is in the Top 10, that horse receives the full \$10,000.

#### 4. \$5,000 Champion Bonus

If an eligible **Kash Money** offspring resulting from the 2027 breeding year is the official winner of the **2 Year Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Stakes** at the 2030 Congress, that horse earns an additional **\$5,000 champion bonus**. The winner may therefore receive both its share of the Top-10 incentive and the \$5,000 bonus.

#### 5. Official Results

Placings will be determined solely from the final official results published or certified by the All American Quarter Horse Congress/OQHA for the 2030 class. Any subsequent official correction, disqualification, or change to results may change incentive eligibility.

#### 6. Ties

If the official 2030 Congress results contain a tie affecting an incentive placing, the final official Congress placing/order will control. If Congress recognizes tied placings without a final order, the affected **Kash Money** incentive amount will be divided equally among the eligible tied horses.

## 7. Recipient of Payment

Unless otherwise announced in writing before the class, incentive money will be payable to the recorded owner of the eligible horse at the time of the 2030 class. The recipient is responsible for supplying any information reasonably required for payment and tax reporting.

## 8. Verification & Claim

Before payment, the owner may be asked to provide the horse's registered name, registration number, ownership information, sire/parentage documentation, **documentation reasonably verifying that the horse is an offspring resulting from the 2027 breeding year**, completed tax form, and payment information. Payment is subject to verification of eligibility and the official 2030 Congress results.

## 9. Disqualification / Ineligibility

A horse that is disqualified from the designated 2030 class, is determined not to be an offspring of Kash Money, **does not result from the 2027 breeding year**, or does not satisfy the published eligibility requirements is not eligible for payment.

## 10. Administration

The Kash Money incentive is a privately funded promotional incentive and is separate from Congress/OQHA/NSBA purses unless expressly stated otherwise. The sponsor may clarify administrative details necessary to resolve an ambiguity, provided the announced \$15,000 incentive structure is not reduced after eligible horses compete.

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
